Answer: 72% Depending on the source Fast Fashion clothing is produced with the aim of selling as much as possible, as quickly as possible. To keep the economy going and create growth for manufacturers, much of the clothing is made so that it becomes obsolete quickly. It goes out of style, or it simply breaks. This means that much of the clothing ends up as waste after a few uses, and valuable material is lost.
